Dr Benny Peiser is the director of the Global Warming Policy Foundation (GWPF), an all-party and non-party, international think tank based in London (UK) and chaired by The Right Honourable Lord Lawson of Blaby. Dr Peiser is a social anthropologist. Before directing the GWPF, he worked as a senior lecturer at Liverpool John Moores University. He has written extensively on international climate and energy policies. A 10km-wide asteroid, Minor Planet (7107) Peiser, was named in his honour by the International Astronomical Union.
