Joyashree Roy is the Professor of Economics at Jadavpur University and the Bangabandhu Chair Professor at the Asian Institute of Technology in Thailand; she is responsible for teaching courses for Doctoral and Masters students to provide research guidance and help in Sustainable Energy Planning and Modelling for Bangladesh. She is ICSSR national fellow and was Ford Foundation Post Doctoral Fellow at LBNL, Berkeley, USA. She initiated and coordinates the Global Change Programme and Ryoichi Sasakawa Young Leaders Fellowship Fund (SYLFF) Project at Jadavpur University. She is in the IPCC-2007 Nobel Peace Prize winning panel, and has been a chapter author of Global Energy Assessment. Dr. Roy is in the winning team of Prince Sultan Bin Aziz award for water, and has published more than 100 peer reviewed journal articles and authored and edited books. Her research interests: Economics of Pollution and Climate Change, Modeling energy demand, Economy-wide modeling exercises for deriving policy implications, Water quality demand modeling, Water pricing, Sustainable development, Natural resource accounting, Valuing environmental services, Developmental and environmental issues relevant for informal sectors, Coastal Ecosystem service evaluation.
